2022 Insurance Cards FAQ

Now that open enrollment is completed and everyone has made their benefit elections for 2022, it is time to prepare for new insurance cards. The benefit elections that you made during open enrollment will go into effect on 1/1/2022. It is important to know where to access this information so that you can communicate your insurance coverage changes to your doctor's office or health care providers. Below are some commonly asked questions regarding insurance cards for the new year.

Will I be receiving new insurance cards?

According to Blue Cross Blue Shield, new insurance cards are sent out to anyone who has made a major change to their insurance plan. For example, if in 2021 you had the Medical RC 4000 insurance plan, but in 2022 you elected to have the Medical HSA 3000 plan, you should expect to receive a new insurance card in the mail. If you did not make a major change for 2022, you will not automatically be sent new insurance cards in the mail.

When will I receive my new insurance cards?

You should expect to receive your new insurance cards in the mail sometime in January. BCBS starts sending out new insurance cards in the first week of 2022, but it can take a couple of weeks for them to be delivered to you. If you do not receive insurance cards in January, please reach out to HR and we will help you.

Where can I go to view my insurance cards?

The quickest and easiest way to view insurance cards is by creating a BCBSM account, or logging into your already existing account. Once you log into the app, there will be an "ID Cards" button that you can press. You can show this virtual ID card to your doctor's office so they will have the information they need to look up your coverage.

How do I request new insurance cards, or extra copies for my family members?

Similar to the previous question, the quickest and easiest way to do this is by logging into your BCBSM account, or use the Mobile App. You will want to click the "ID Card" button as shown to the left. Then, there will be an "Order Card" option as shown in the picture to the right. Once the cards are requested, it takes about two weeks for you to receive them in the mail.

Why do the copies I requested for my family members have my name on it, and not theirs?

Insurance cards only have the name of the policyholder on the insurance card. Though the names of your covered dependents are not listed on the insurance card, they can still use your insurance cards at the doctor's office. This will not cause problems with finding their coverage.

Where do I go to create a BCBSM account?

Go to <u>bcbsm.com</u>, and in the upper-right corner of the home page, click the Login tab. Then, click the "Register Now" button.

You can also download the mobile app using the Apple App Store or the Google Play store, and search for BCBSM. Once you download the app, click "Register."

2021 Tax Forms FAQ



The end of the year is right around the corner, which means tax documents will be generated and sent soon! Here's what you need to know for this year:

When will my W-2 be available?

W-2s will be available for viewing online by mid to late January, and they will be mailed to your mailing address on file by January 31st.

How will I receive my W-2?

W-2s will be mailed to the mailing address we have on file for you and will also be available on Paylocity. If you elected to receive Paperless documents, then you will only be able to view your W-2 online.


Where can I find my W-2 online?

Once it is available, you can find your W-2 by logging in to Paylocity, navigating to the Self-Service Portal, and clicking on the orange button that says, 'View Employee Record'. Once there, navigate to the 'Pay' tab, and click the 'Tax Forms' subtab to see all of your past tax forms.

What do I need to do now?

Right now, you should take a second to log in to Paylocity to confirm that all your personal information is correct. W-2s and other tax documents are sent to the mailing address we have on file for you, so it is **VERY IMPORTANT** to make sure you provide us with the correct address. If you have a change to make, you can do so yourself by navigating to your Employee Record on Paylocity using the steps mentioned above. Once there, make your changes and be sure to click 'save' when you're done.

You should also take a moment to review your tax setup. You can find this by going to your Employee Record, navigate to the 'Pay' tab, and clicking the 'Tax Setup' subtab. If you've moved recently, double-check to make sure you have the correct state and local taxes being deducted from your check.
